At the election of supervisor for the Southern Drainage District yesterday Mr. L. T. Highleyman was elected. The supervisors made an affidavit that no bonds have been sold or issued. Supervisors also passed a resolution that no plan of reclamation will be put into effect, tax levied or bonds issued without approval of a majority of the landowners. Also the landowners organized a Southern Drainage District Landowners League, so that the supervisors would have a means of dealing with the landowners. The league is to have another meeting next Monday afternoon. Mr. James H. Bright called in this afternoon and told me that friends had persuaded him to run for supervisor for the Broward Drainage District. He says he wants to push things and do good work right away.
