SUBJECT: Southern Drainage District.

Gentlemen:

I have your letters of June 11th and 12th with reference to the annual meeting of the Southern Drainage District at which time Mr. J. L. Holmberg was elected Supervisor for the next three years by a vote of 29,005 as against 10,966 votes cast for Mr. R. R. Kerr and, while Mr. Holmberg may be perfectly all right for a Supervisor, at the same time I must admit that I am very much disappointed that Mr. Kerr was not elected one of the Supervisors of this District and I am wondering how it happened that Mr. Holmberg was able to poll nearly 19,000 more votes than Mr. Kerr and what acreage was voted for Mr. Holmberg. It seems to me this might be worth investigating.

From the Auditor's report it appears that the District is in fairly good financial condition, although they have considerable delinquent taxes and certificates.

I am sending you herewith 20¢ in stamps to reimburse you for the Documentary Stamps which we failed to attach to the two proxies.
