While Mr. Pepper and I were at Mr. Hoffman's home last Tuesday we called his attention to the fact that the Land Owners Meeting of the Southern Drainage District was June 12, 1933, and Mr. Pepper told Mr. Hoffman you could attend it and represent the Model and Perrine Grant Companies if he wanted you to, but Mr. Pepper suggested to Mr. Hoffman that he thought it might be a good idea to have Tommy Bennett attend it as it was a tax matter pure and simple. We told Mr. Hoffman that Mr. Siegel was up for reelection as Supervisor and we thought he should be reelected. He made notes of what we said and unless you hear from him instructing you to attend you need not do so.

We suggested to him that if Mr. Bennett attended it might be advisable to try and have the Land Owners request the Supervisors to have a bill passed in the Legislature providing for no levy for the next two years, with the idea that the Legislature might be called back again this Fall.
