Dear Milo:

I am enclosing the Southern Drainage District file, about which I talked with Mr. Hoffman this morning. I think he has about come to the conclusion the best way to clean up this mess is to put through a Bill at this Session of the Legislature annulling the Drainage District. I told him Mr. Garrison informed me that his attorney was at the present time preparing a Bill to cover not only the Southern Drainage District but also the Dade, Little River and Biscayne Districts, and that Mr. Garrison promised over the phone a copy of the Bill as soon as prepared by his attorney.

It is Mr. Hoffman's desire that you keep in touch with Mr. Garrison and you may also inform him that our company is in sympathy with this movement and will be glad to cooperate in any way we can and to this end desire to have a copy of the proposed Bill as soon as it is prepared.

I think, in this connection, that Mr. Hoffman does not think it necessary to inform Mr. Conrad, or any other officers of the District, as to what we are doing. I told Mr. Hoffman that you would keep me posted during my absence.
