Dear Mr. Harrison:

In pursuance with your letter of the 7th inst.,
and my reply of the 8th.

I arranged to attend the meeting of the landowners of the Southern Drainage District on the afternoon of the 14th inst. The meeting was well represented and after organizing, with myself in the chair, we proceeded to elect supervisor to continue expiration of Mr. Conrad's term. When the ballots were checked up it was found that Mr. Conrad had been elected unanimously for another term.

In anticipation of this meeting the landowners league of the Southern Drainage District called a meeting on Friday afternoon of the 11th inst., for the purpose of recommending to the Supervisors filling of different offices for the next year, and the following recommendations were made: Capt. J. F. Jaudon, President or Chairman of the Board, Frank F. Shutts, Attorney and W. V. Blackwell, the present Secretary, to succeed himself. At a later meeting of the Supervisors these suggestions were acted upon and appointments made as recommended.

We listened to reports of the Board of Supervisors for the past year and find that they have done very well with facilities at hand. We gave the Supervisors to understand that the landowners were closely watching expenses, and they assured us that they would be as saving in the future as they could.

At the present time there is no money in the treasury, and in view of the present conditions of the bond market, the Supervisors, I think, are inclined not to do anything for a few months, until the financial market is in better shape, which idea was also concenanced by the landowners.
