I was aware that

Mr. Conrad, as Supervisor, was favored by Governor Jennings at the time he had the matter in hand for you.

As to the appointment of an Attorney. I understand this is within the jurisdiction of the Supervisors, but still at the same time, the Landowners League has a mutual understanding with the Supervisors that such matters will be acted on largely according to recommendations from the Landowners League, in fact, Mr. Conrad personally told me quite recently that he knew of no reason why recommendations of the landowners in this matter would not be carried out by the Supervisors and that will be one of the most important matters to come up for consideration at our next meeting.

The meeting of the Board of Broward District Supervisors is arranged for the morning of the 14th and the meeting of the Southern District for the afternoon of the same day so that those of us who wish to can arrange to attend both meetings and I hope therefore to be present at both meetings.

The matter of fee to be charged by the District Attorney is one that will be given careful consideration by the Landowners League before any recommendation is made, and I will be glad to use my best judgment in representing your interests.
