Dear Mr. Bennett:

We note from the Tax Sale in the Southern Drainage District in July 1919 that $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 35-54-40 was sold for unpaid drainage taxes in Southern Drainage District for year 1917 (preliminary taxes)

A small tract of this land lying east of the Right-of-Way is still owned by the Model Land Company. Also you deeded this land to Mr. Griffing in 1917 and he was supposed to pay us 1917 taxes at time of delivering deed. What do wish to have done with this tax sale?

Also in this same advertisement is included $N\frac{3}{4}$ of $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{2}$. This was sold to Carrie S. Wyrick for cash and deed issued in 1917, therefore, should not the Model Land Company redeem this?

Also in same advertisement is $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 35-54-40, owned by Model Land Company. Should this not be redeemed?
