The Landowners of the Southern Drainage District, representing some seventy thousand acres of land, held a meeting this day in the office of the Southern Drainage District, at Miami, Florida; Mr. F. O. Bendle called the meeting to order and proposed that a Landowners League be formed and that a chairman and secretary be elected.

Dr. J. L. Holmberg and W. V. Blackwell were elected Chairman and Secretary, respectively, of the meeting.

Capt. J. F. Jaudon moved that the name of the League be the Southern Drainage District Landowner's League, said motion was seconded by Mr. L. T. Highleyman and duly carried.

Capt. J. F. Jaudon also moved that the purpose of the League be that of co-operating in the matter of taxes, road, and general betterment of lands in the Southern Drainage District, subject to an enlargement of scope when the constitution and by-laws of the League were adopted. Said motion was duly seconded and carried.

Mr. Edward Wilson moved that the Chairman appoint a committee of three to draft by-laws and constitution, which was upon vote carried.

The Chairman appointed Capt. Jaudon, F. H. Siegel and F. O. Bendle as a committee.

It was moved, seconded and carried that the League adjourn and meet again on Monday, June 23, at 3 P. M. at the office of the Southern Drainage District.
