SUBJECT: Southern Drainage District.

Memorandum.

In conversation with Mr. Hoffman today in this office, he suggested that we consult with proper officers of the Southern Drainage District to see what their plans are with reference to carrying on in the future, and if necessary to have any action taken by the present Legislature, it should be looked into without delay.

He also suggested that at the next election of Supervisors when Mr. Highleyman will be replaced, that in accordance with an understanding we had with some of the Supervisors last year, the Model Land Company would like to have someone replace Mr. Highleyman that could be considered as a representative of the Model and Ferrine Grant Land Companies. It is my idea to talk with Fred Siegel first and then probably with Conrad regarding the matter.
