Dear Sir:

We have your letter of the 15th instant in regard to above.

We attended the adjourned drainage meeting on Monday, August 11th, at which meeting there were several resolutions adopted, which Mr. Blackwell, the Secretary, took down in shorthand at the meeting and requested him to send us a copy of the minutes when he wrote them up so we could make a report to you, which he promised to do. We have phoned him several times during the week and each time he promises to get the minutes out that day. He has now made us a definite promise to get them to us next Monday and we will keep after him and try to get them and forward same to you. We would go over and copy them ourselves but we cannot read his shorthand.

One of the resolutions requested the Board of Supervisors to have Megathlin & Clark remove an abandoned dredge from one of the canals South of the Trail which was damming up the canal, and another resolution requested the Supervisors to have an abandoned and sunken barge removed from the Tamiami Canal. A third resolution made the statement that the Krome Avenue Canal dumped its water at its present terminus in Township 55-39 and that the water, instead of running in a southeasterly direction, flowed northeasterly past the County Farm and emptied into Snapper Creek Canal which was already overloaded, and this resolution requested the Supervisors to try to get aid from the State in having the Krome Avenue Canal extended southeasterly thru Black Point Creek to empty into the Bay near the Goulds Canal.
