Mr. Coffrin and the writer attended the adjourned meeting of the landowners of the Southern Drainage District on July 8th and we are handing you herewith copy of resolutions which were passed at that meeting, which just about covers what transpired.

Some of the property owners who live back in the Glades, of course, wanted a lot of work done by the District, and there were others there who wanted some certain canals cleaned out and others there who thought the District should be disbanded, etc. In other words, none of them could agree, and I can't see that what transpired will have any effect upon the policy of the Supervisors. Mr. Conrad assured me after the meeting that it did not make any difference what these few landowners asked for, he was not going to see the District thrown into debt.

You will note that the landowners adjourned the meeting until Monday, August 11th, for another meeting at that time to see what, if anything, could be offered by the Supervisors along the lines of these resolutions.
