Gentlemen:-

I acknowledge receipt of, and thank you for your letter of June 9th, with your report of the Southern Drainage District Land Owners annual meeting, held June 9th, and note that Mr. Siegel was unanimously elected to succeed himself as Supervisor.

I expect the statement of Mr. Conrad, that the District will be obligated to levy a tax this year, is quite correct. However, I shall be glad if you will keep in touch with the situation and see that the levy is made as low as possible.

I note that some of the land owners protested the question of not levying a tax for 1931, and also suggested a bond issue to relieve the present situation, and I am wondering whether or not these land owners have paid their taxes. Probably not - as rule the non taxpayers are the ones who feel that they are not getting all they should from a District of this nature.
