Put on Southern Drainage & Irrigation 655 1/2

Memorandum.

While in St. Augustine on the 13th instant I had a talk with Mr. Hoffman regarding election of a Supervisor for the Southern Drainage District to take place this coming June on the expiration of the term of present Supervisor Fred H. Siegel. Mr. Hoffman expressed himself as being satisfied with the performance of Mr. Siegel and stated that in the absence of any further information he was willing to pledge the support of the Model and Perrine Grant Land Companies for the return of Mr. Siegel to office, but stated further he felt like that at the expiration of the term of Mr. Highleyman that we should consider replacing him with someone of our choice who would be free to protect the interests of the Company. I told him I felt satisfied we could reach a satisfactory agreement with Conrad and Siegel on someone to replace Mr. Highleyman when the time came, which it is my understanding will be a year hence.
