Gentlemen:-

I acknowledge receipt of, and thank you for your letter of June 10th, giving report of the annual meeting of the land owners of the Southern Drainage District, held in Miami on Monday, June 10th.

I note that out of a possible total vote of 144,000, 96,000 were represented either in proxy or person, and that Mr. Conrad was unanimously elected to succeed himself for the next three years as Supervisor.

I am very glad that the resolution was passed requesting Supervisors to do no further work in Township 55 of Ranges 39 and 40, that would tend to lower the water table. I am also glad to note the resolution asking that Supervisors do not make a tax levy for the year 1930. We will keep this matter before us and notify the Supervisors sometime in December, calling attention to this resolution.

I feel we have accomplished about as much as could reasonably be expected, in view of the fact that the tax levy for 1929 had already been made, and I am sure the good representation of property owners will have a tendency to cause the Supervisors to exercise caution in the future management of the District.
