Dear Mr. Conrad:

The letter and resolution which you sent me June 25th was presented to the Board of Commissioners of Everglades Drainage District at their meeting yesterday.

The Board in informal action expressed their appreciation of your letter and resolution and wish to thank you for the friendly spirit and co-operation expressed at your meeting and to assure you that the Everglades Drainage District wishes to act in whole-hearted co-operation with you and with the Southern Drainage District.

You will find advertised in the Miami Daily News within the next few days a budget of the Everglades Drainage District which includes some work to be done in the Snapper Creek and Comfort Canals. This budget is tentative only and subject to change in the meeting to be held in this office on August 4, 1931, at 10 a. m.

If your district has means available for doing whatever work is necessary in these canals during the coming year, we would appreciate having that information at the hearings and no doubt the Board would be glad to remove all Maintenance taxes for the Everglades Drainage District on your land under those conditions. You might also discuss this matter with Mr. Milan prior to the meeting.
