The June meeting of the Land Owners League of the Southern Drainage District will be the 10th. anniversary of the election of Supervisor Joe Conrad.

Conrad has served us faithfully and in his newspaper articles has given us more favorable publicity to the lands than any other medium, I personally know of two instances where his careful auditing of the estimates has saved the district, in one instance \$5300 and in the other \$7900 which saving amounts to more than his entire salary for the ten years service.

His bill, which he had passed in the last legislature lifting the tax entirely for the year 1927 is in a class by itself just at this time when practically every public official was up there adding to our tax burden by increasing their salaries instead of giving us relief.

Public service such as Conrad has given us should be recognized at this annual meeting, especially as it is his 10th anniversary either by resolutions of commendation or otherwise.

I only own 320 acres in the district but his bill saves me \$320 which is very acceptable just at this time and of course it means a much larger saving to the big land owners.

This bill is a life saver to those who had lot plats recorded and have the true ownership in doubt as it gives them time to quash the plats and settle their ownership problems.
