We received your letter of September 29th in regard to above.

We communicated with Mr. J. D. Redd, County Commissioner in the Homestead District, yesterday, and he stated he submitted the estimate to the Board of County Commissioners of Monroe County as we advised you in our letter of August 29th, since which time he has heard nothing further from it and nothing has been done.

Mr. Redd stated that when he had his conference with the Monroe County Commissioner before he secured the estimate on this work he gained the impression from their conversation, that the Monroe County Commissioners did not know where they were going to get the money to do the work with and he thought possibly the work was delayed because of lack of funds.

Mr. Redd stated that while he was, of course, anxious to see this bridge and road repaired, that since it was outside of Dade County, and, therefore, did not come under his jurisdiction, he was not in a position to take any further action in the matter, but suggested that any further handling should be with the County Commissioners of Monroe County. It, therefore, seems to us that it might be well to bring some pressure to bear on the County Commissioners of Monroe County if you have any means of doing this.
