Dear Sir:

Our last letter to you on this subject was under date of August 2nd. Your Mr. Lee came in this morning to see if we had anything further on this subject and as we had heard nothing from Mr. Loudon who promised to do what he could to secure a Contractor's bid on the work, we called up Mr. J. D. Redd, County Commissioner in the Homestead District, with the idea of asking his assistance in securing a bid on this job, and Mr. Redd informed us that just during the last two or three days, a couple of the County Commissioners of Monroe County called upon him, requesting the same cooperation, and furnishing him with a map showing the location of the bridge, and that he has requested a party living near Homestead who has been doing some work for Dale County along this line, to go down and look over the proposition and submit a bid, which information he is to pass on to the Monroe County Commissioners as soon as obtained, which he thinks should be within the next week or ten days, and possibly sooner.

Mr. Redd promised that if he was unsuccessful in getting this information for the Monroe County Commissioners that he would advise us so that we could pursue the matter further if desired.
