Dear Sir,

We have your letter of the 25th instant.

When Mr. Jaudon was calling on Mr. Ingraham, he told him what the Monroe County Commissioners were considering, as an enclosed blue print, M1 refers to a proposed appropriation for \$400000.- for road from Key West and ferry to Cape Sable.

M 2 refers to a proposed appropriation of \$100000.- for a rock road from Cape Sable to connect with the Ingraham Highway at the County line.

M 3 refers to a proposed appropriation of \$100000.- connecting the Ingraham Highway with the Tamiami Trail, in this project the State is supposed to furnish \$100000.- and Dade Co. is supposed to furnish \$100000.- I spoke to Mr. Brumley about this when he was here.

M 4 refers to a proposed road appropriation to Chevalier of \$100000.- This is Mr. Jaudon's information and map. He says you have to keep after the County Commissioners to get them to do anything, which of course means spend money. The above matters are proposed Monroe County expenditures. On Key Largo is marked the road already constructed. And to the east of Florida City is marked a road connecting Tatum's road to the Bay with a road to the south and a proposed ferry to Key Largo. This road it is proposed that Dade County shall build.
