My dear Morse:

Replying to yours of the 27th ult., the County Judge's records show that a dower interest was set aside to Mrs. Thompson in certain lands in Key West. She has never elected to take a child's part in her husband's estate.

Saw Curry, relative to Cape gable roads, and he says that there was a tacit agreement between the owners of the property at that place with the County Commissioners, prior to the election for bonds for road purposes, to the effect that that part of Monroe County would be bonded as a separate road district and that the large real estate owners, presumably Model Land Co., and others, would buy the bonds so that the work could go on. Up to the present time the bonds have not been sold, notwithstanding they have been duly advertised, etc.

You can readily see that these bonds are not on the same par with other road bonds, inasmuch as the issue is based on just the road district and naturally would not be an inducement to any one except those who are to be directly interested in road building. The bonds have been printed and are ready for sale, only waiting a purchaser.
