Gentlemen:-

A number of years ago there was planted in the Ferrine Grant a number of rubber trees. I do not remember the exact number but believe there were several hundred of them and that they were planted in every section of the Grant. They were secured through the assistance of Mr. Fairchild of the Department and were planted through the assistance of Mr. Burnan of Augusta, Georgia.

I believe rubber can be produced commercially with profit in Florida and I would like to secure photographs of these trees. Possibly Mr. Livingston of the Chamber of Commerce can give you some help on it.
