Dear Mr. Ingraham:

In regard to the rubber situation, I am sorry I haven't been able to make much progress as yet, for the reason, principally, that I have been laid up for four or five weeks and unable to get out much on account of the operation on my throat which caused me quite a little trouble and still under treatment.
