Dear Sir:

In connection with the proposed refund of \$640.00 to Mrs. Marshall. We are just in receipt of advice from Mr. Ingraham to the effect that the Company's Attorney, Mr. Dewhurst advises that on account of the unsettled status of this estate it appears to him that it is uncertain who is entitled to receive this money and therefore thinks that you should have your Attorney file a supplemental petition with Judge Donnell stating that you have found assets of Carlton Marshall's estate in the sum of \$640.00 and asking that an order be made as to whom it shall be paid.
