I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 30th. instant making suggestions with reference to getting action in both the Dade Drainage District and the Biscayne Drainage District.

At a meeting of the Supervisors of the Biscayne Drainage District this afternoon, it was decided that before making further definite steps towards letting contracts in our district that we would notify those interested in the Dade Drainage District to meet with those interested in the Biscayne Drainage District and see if we could not settle the question of co-operation between the two districts. This meeting has been set for 3 P. M. Wednesday November 7th. in the Assembly Room of the Chamber of Commerce and as you are closely in touch with the property owners of the Biscayne Drainage District, who are mostly interested in the proposition, I would like to request that you get in touch with them and see that they are advised of this meeting so that they can be present if they wish.
