Dear Sir:

Your letter about the Biscayne Drainage District report came and I have noted what you say about submitting these plans to the property owners.

This is doubtless a good idea, but in view of the fact that the County Commissioners meet only once a month, I have deemed it advisable to file the report with them at this time and proceed to ask for bids from contractors for the construction of the canal. Two propositions will be submitted to the bidders. One which will make the canal as it has been usually discussed, which would be a wide canal, the other would make this a narrow canal, but would run an additional canal into Arch Creek. While we are waiting for these bids the entire matter may be taken up and discussed with the property owners. The items of expense will exceed what anybody anticipated I believe, and it is well enough that they know this before bids of contractors for the work are accepted. Perhaps you will return to Town in the near future and can call a meeting with the property owners at an early date.
