Dear Sir :-

In connection with our previous correspondence giving especial reference to your letter of January 24th. concerning the above outlined subject, wish to state for your information, that we are in receipt of a letter from Thompson & Jackson, stating that they wish to oppose this movement and do not want to have any of their lands included in such a Drainage District.

We have likewise received a letter from Mr. Sawyer, President of the Boston and Florida Atlantic Coast Land Company, stating that he will place the matter before his Executive Committee but is quite certain that they will not want to approve of a Drainage District.

We have had a conference with Mr. Hunter who seems to be one of the active spirits in this movement and who expressed himself as being greatly disappointed that the Model Land Company could not see its way clear to approve of the project.

We may hear from them further and of course will watch the matter as closely as we can, but, our opinion is that this will likely be the end of the movement for the present.
