Gentlemen:

I have your very interesting letter of December 28th, referring to the communication addressed to Mr. Rainey of December 22nd, which I have very carefully read.

Mr. Harrison, who has had all the negotiations with Mr. Deane, is out of the office on a short holiday, and will not return until about the 3rd or 4th. Meanwhile, I suggest you show this letter to Mr. Rainey and ask him to withhold his reply until we can advise you further.
