Gentlemen:-

There has been a movement on foot for the past few months started by some of our friends in the Southern part of Dade County for the formation of a Drainage District, which would take in a considerable area of the Southeast corner of Dade County and including most of your lands in that section. We have, of course, kept closely in touch with the situation and up to this time have taken a stand of opposition as Representative of the Model Land Company, The Boston & Florida Atlantic Coast Land Company and your interests, for the reason that it has not appeared that such a proposition would be to the best interests of our companies.

We are merely dropping you this line to post you in case you are approached in the matter directly by some Committee, and would suggest that you let us control the matter in unity with the Model Land Company and the Boston Company. Of course, it goes without saying that it is not our intention to commit you definitely, either in favor or against the proposition, until we have secured what we consider necessary information to come to an intelligent conclusion, at which time we will of course make a full and complete report to you.
