
Gentlemen:

Kindly refer to your letter of Feb. 15th in which you advise me that the officials of The Boston and Florida Atlantic Coast Land Co. and The Thompson and Jackson Land Co. would probably be in Miami between the 20th and the end of February, at which time you would obtain from them an expression in regard to the proposed drainage of lands south of Florida City and their participation in the cost of the necessary survey.
