Dear Sir:

While on an inspection trip over the South  
end of our territory the latter part of last week, we  
stopped in at Mr. Holferty's farm to look over the ex-  
perimental planting of sugar cane.

Mr. Holferty advised us that Representatives  
or Agents from the Department, at Canalpoint had recent-  
ly made an inspection and secured specimens for test  
purposes, and that he had since received a letter or re-  
port showing results which he understood to be quite sat-  
isfactory.

As this is the first information we had obtained  
regarding these tests, we are thinking that likely you also  
have not received them and may wish to write to the proper  
parties at Canalpoint for information.

Mr. Holferty advised us further that the Agents  
instructed him to have all the cane cut back and certain  
other work done so that a new growth could be secured and  
observed.
