Gentlemen:-

Referring to your letter of February
19th, relative to the above subject.

I am today in receipt of a letter from
Mr. E. W. Brandes, Principal Pathologist in
Charge, Office of Sugar Plants, U. S. Department
of Agriculture, Washington, D. C. which reads in
part as follows,-

" - - We will be very glad to cooperate
by furnishing cuttings of the most promising
varieties. I suggest that the varieties
known as 36, 213, and 234 P.O.J., and C.P.
807 be tried. I will advise our agronomist,
Mr. R. T. Gibbens, at Canal Point, to furnish
you with cuttings of these varieties as soon
as they are available. Probably a few cut-
tings of each of these varieties could be
furnished immediately but it will be some
time before any larger quantities would be
available."

Will you please get in touch with Mr.
Holferty and ascertain from him whether or not
it is possible for him to get these plants from
Canal Point, or if we should request that they be
sent to him by mail or express.
