Upon receipt of your letter of the 15th instant we wrote Mr. Holferty to see if the experiment had progressed to a point where he could make a report on the possibility of growing cane on marl soil, and we have just heard from Mr. Holferty from Chicago, stating our letter had followed him to St. Louis, Falls City, Neb., and Chicago before catching up with him.
