We called Mr. McDougal's attention to the fact that these descriptions, or the majority of them, were part of the tract we had marked on our map as being owned by Mr. Peters. Mr. McDougal stated that Mr. Peters started to purchase these lands several years ago under contract but he has not completed the balance of the first payment as provided by the contract, and this tract is really owned by Mr. McCord and the Chevalier Corporation.
