Gentlemen:-

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of November 2nd, enclosing letter dated October 31st, from J. P. Conrad, Supervisor and Treasurer of the Southern Drainage District, relative to the proposed formation of the Dade Conservancy District which, I understand, would mean the combining of all of the now existing Drainage Districts in Dade County.

I had not heard of this proposition before, and while Mr. Conrad's position seems to be well taken, at the same time, however, if it would mean a reduction in drainage taxes in the County, I think it should be considered.
