We enclose you herewith a letter dated October 31st, just received from Mr. J. P. Conrad, Supervisor and Treasurer of the Southern Drainage District, from which you will note he is considerably concerned and worked up over some propaganda that is being circulated with a view of forming what has been referred to as "Dade Conservancy District," for the purpose of supplanting or amalgamating all of the other drainage districts now in existence in the County.
