Dear Milo:

You might also state you happen to know I ~~xxxx~~ seem to have considerable influence with the Supervisors and also with the land owners in the meetings, and could probably successfully work out any consistent policies desired.

You will likely receive a wire from me by the time you get this regarding change of address, as it now looks as though we will pull out from here sometime next week for Duluth for a few days. Will probably ask you to send the mail to Tomshawk. The full address is
