Dear Sir:

We received your letter of the 8th instant  
stating the 1930 taxes on the 1760 acres were \$162.80,  
the 1931 and 1932 taxes not having been paid.

We note you do not own the land in Section  
25-60-31, about which we inquired.

In reply to the last paragraph of your letter,  
will state that we quoted the land to Mr. Dillon at approx-  
imately \$6.00 an acre, or a round figure of \$10,500.00,
