You know Govt employees are not allowed to mess up with State legislation but in this way you can get him there in a legitimate way.

Keep in touch with him and if possible get your bill drafted before the session and have it introduced the first day but be sure and have some live

man to push it.. Heretofore my
trouble has been that the bill has
always been handled by an incompetent
person and being in the Federal
Service I could say nothing, but
you can..
