

the Lake. This would not be the most
direct route ^{but} would be the least expensive.
On this ~~the~~ route the deepest cut would
be between Apopka & Butler, at best
however, it would be a very expensive
proposition. I would not feel equal
to the task of making the survey and
would not care to undertake it.

As to a timber tract. You might write to
J. D. Beggs Jr., of Orlando, who has several
timber tracts which you might sell and
divvy Com^{ms} with him. Mr. Bullock also
of Orlando has a large timber tract in
Orange and I think some of it in
Oreola, in the Lake Point vicinity, a
R.R. intersects his tract. In a Colony tract
write to E. F. Baxter, Orlando, who will also
divvy Com^{ms} with you, he has a good Colony
tract, if not already sold.

As to the 4000 acre tract in Palm & Dunbar;
There is ^{not} a tract of that size in So Fla that
will average 500 ft to the acre and I venture
the assertion that there is not a tract in S. F.
that size that will cut 3000 ft to the acre
with best wishes and hoping Mr. William
