I wish to thank you for your favor regarding the 80 acres in the Cow Creek, Old Polly Parker home place, which our Society Friends of the Florida Seminole Indians, purchased and made the deed in the name of Bishop Crane Gray as President.

In 1919 there was a tax certificate gotten against this land and I took the matter up with the Comptroller, and he ordered it cancelled and the money of the debt sent to me. I then notified the assessor not to assess it again, but in some way it got back on the books. The truth about the matter I think is that Mr. Coats wants that land, and is the same man who has the tax certificate before.
