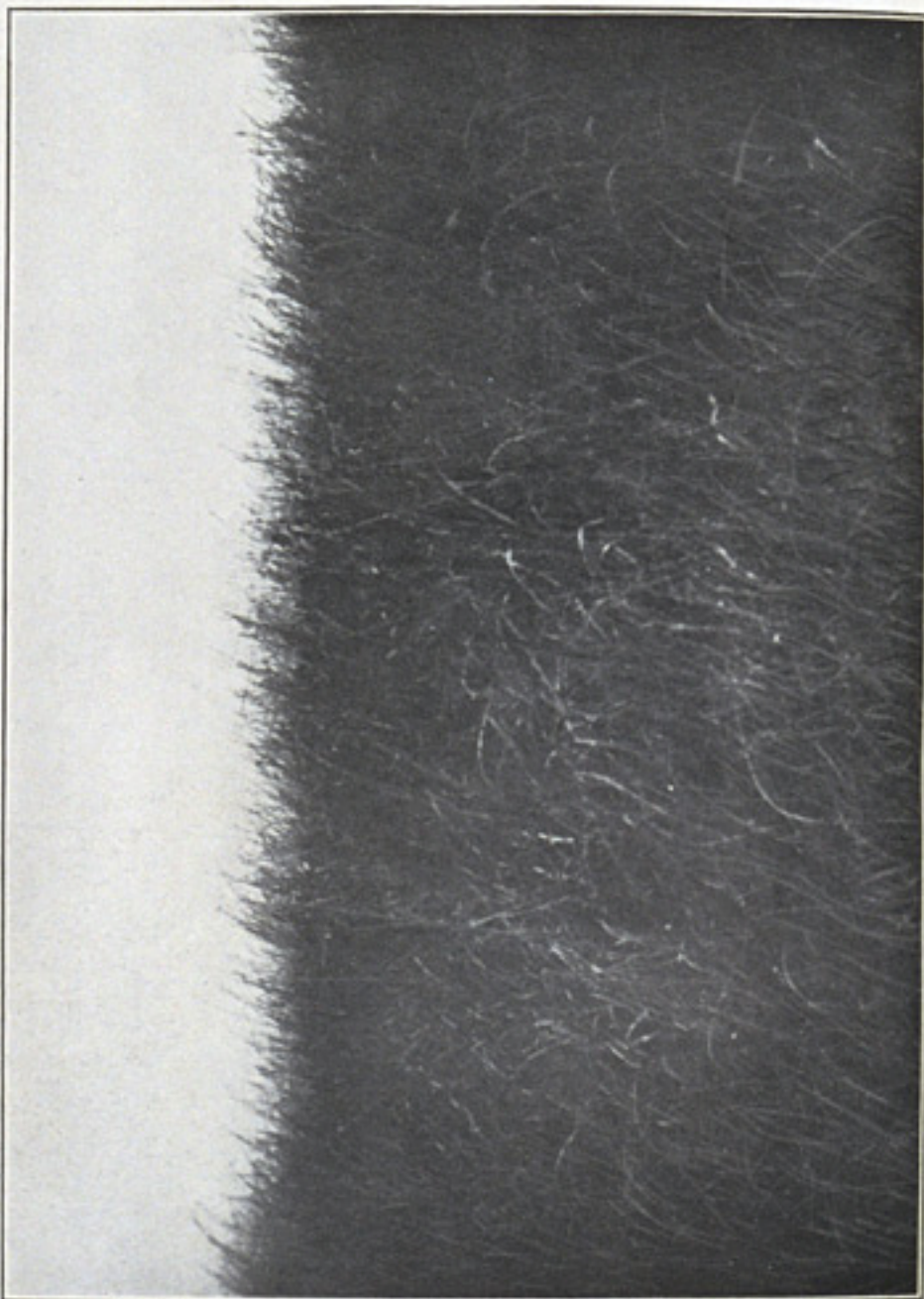

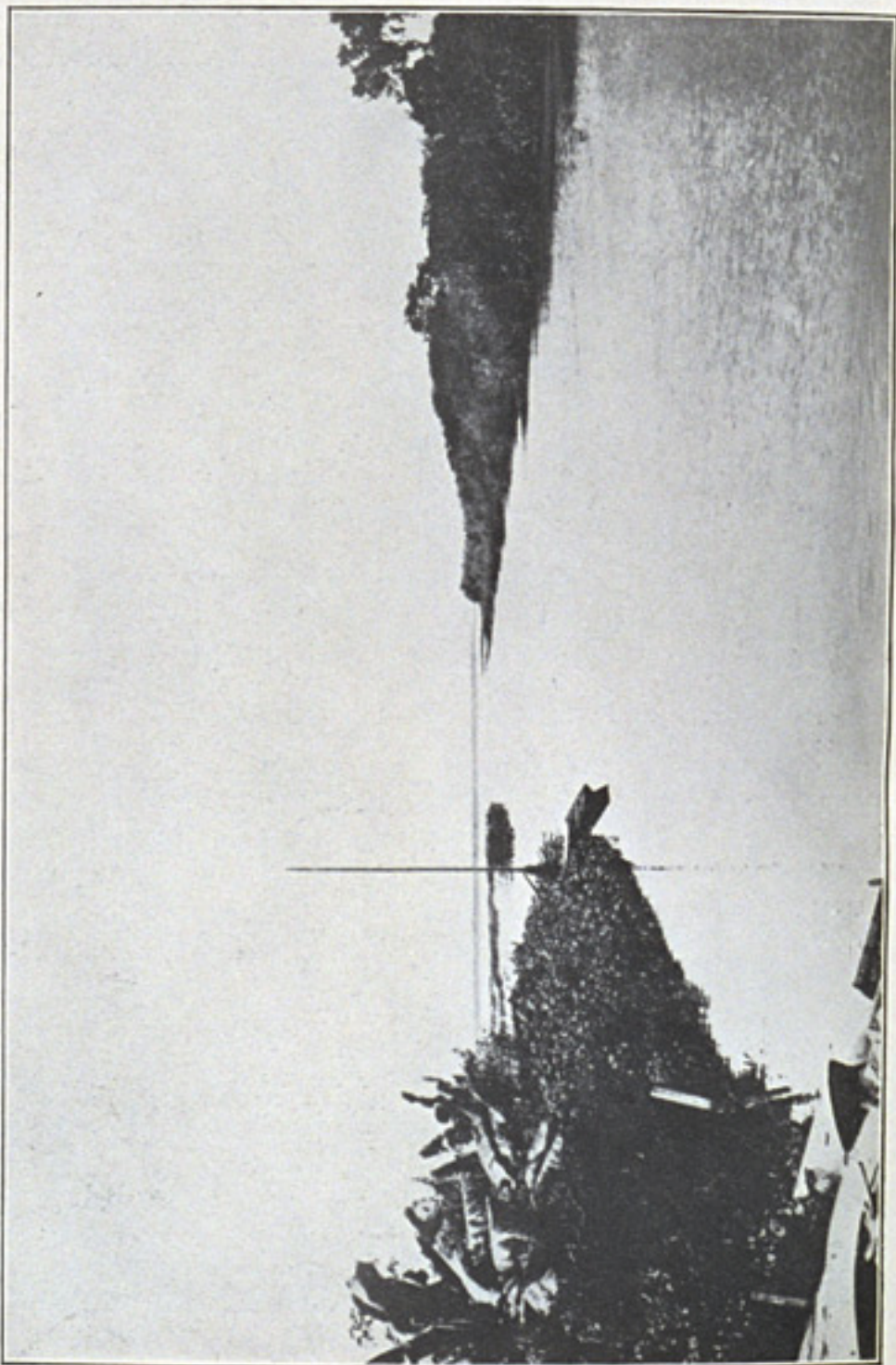

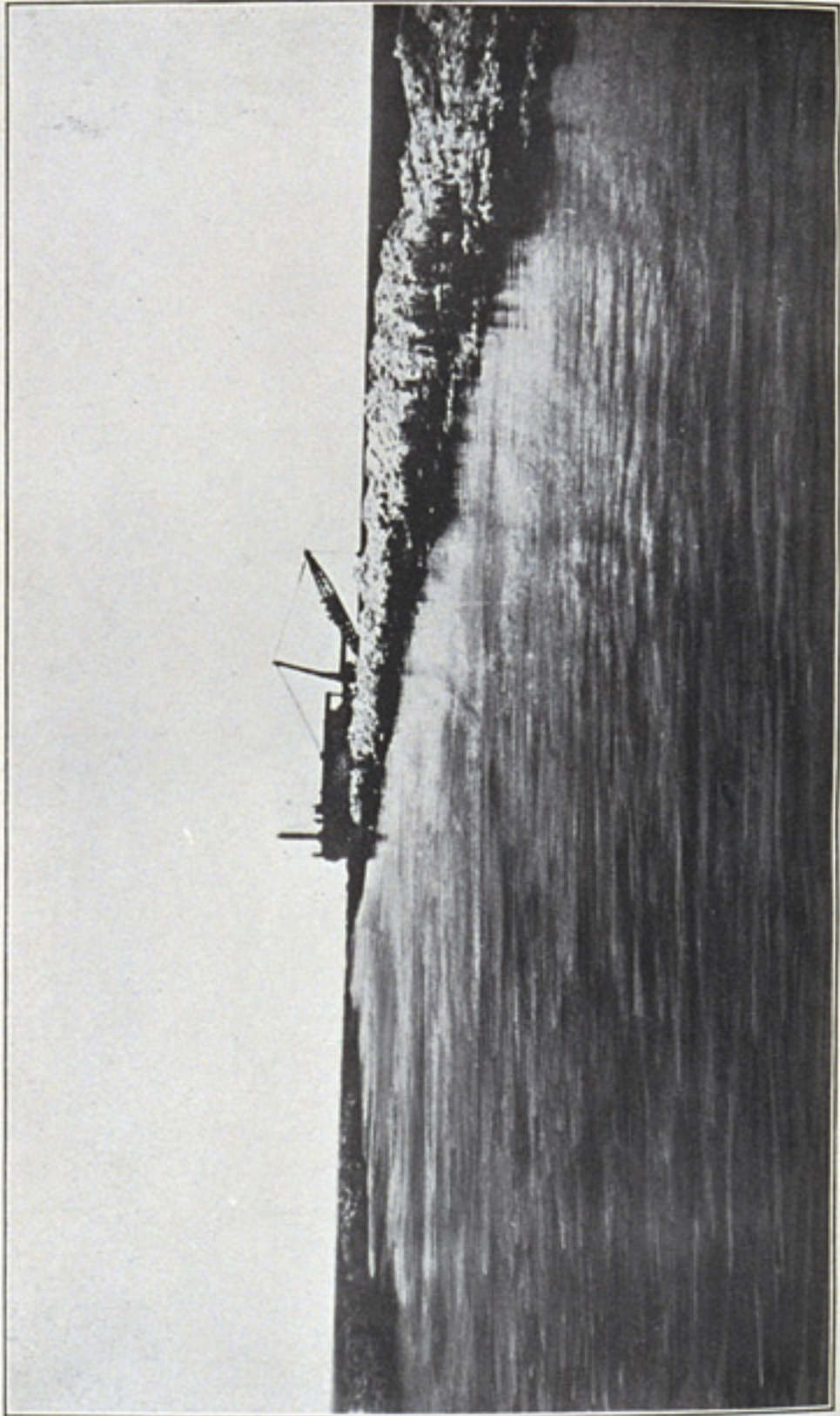

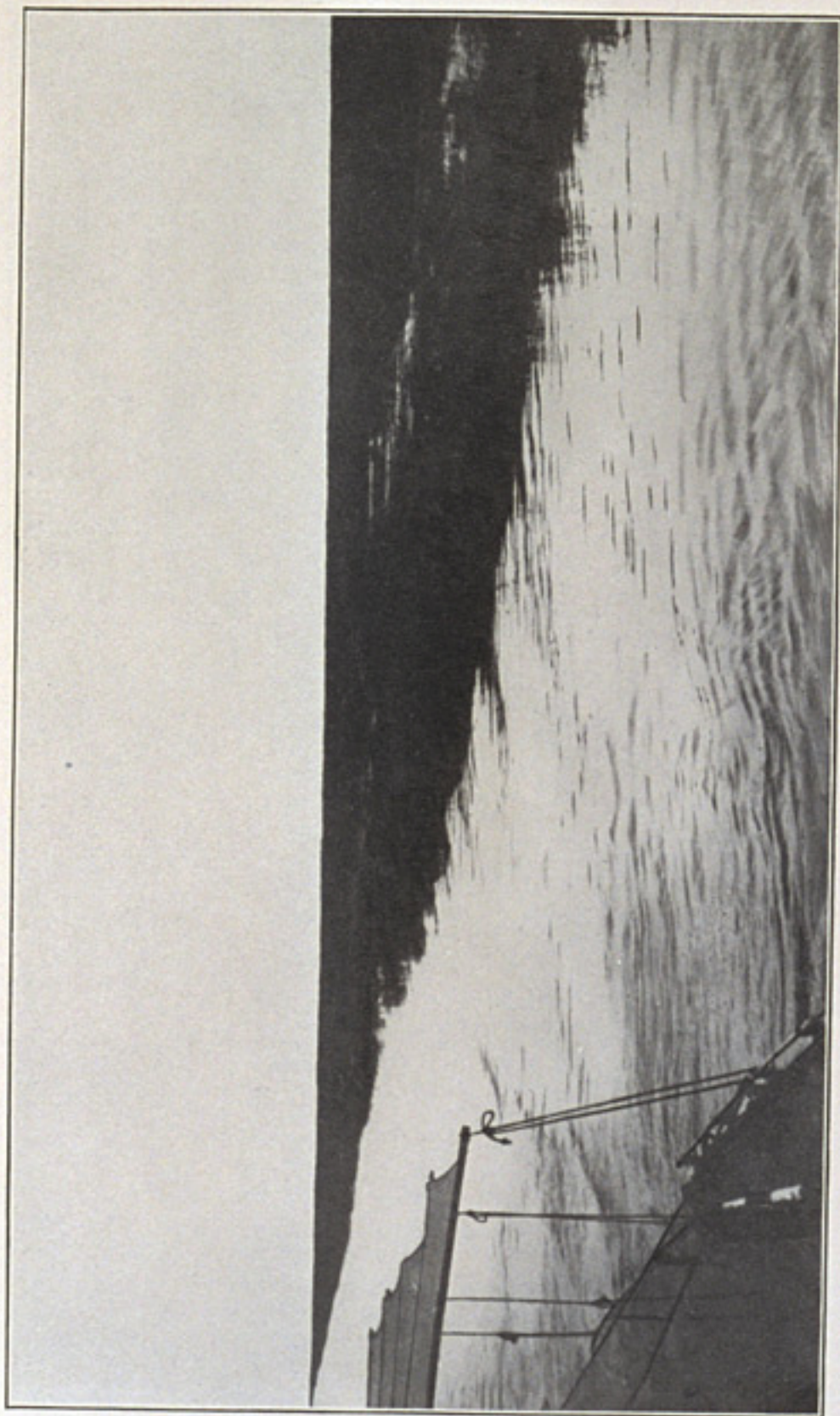

HILLSBOROUGH CANAL AND STATE DREDGE.

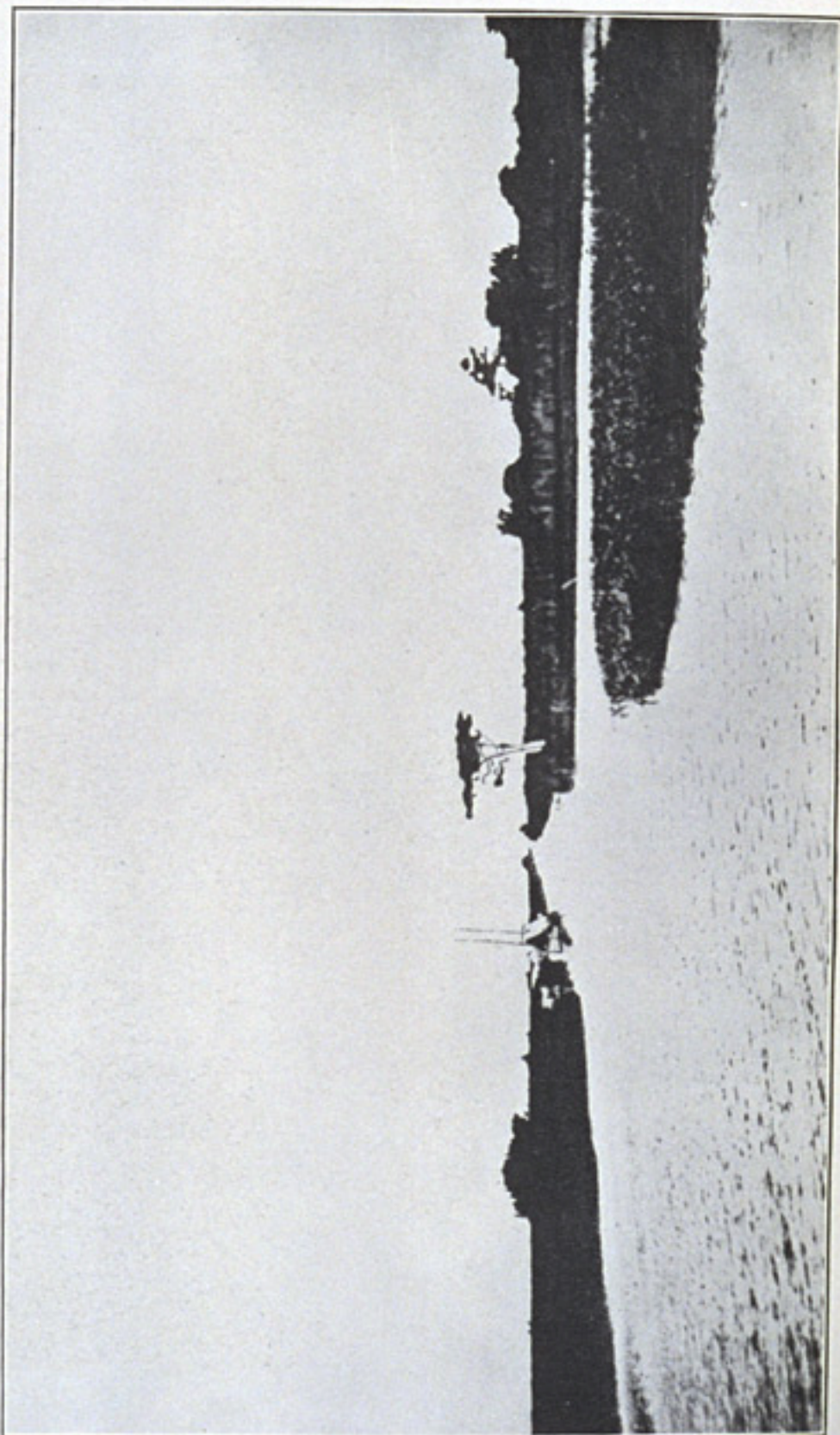

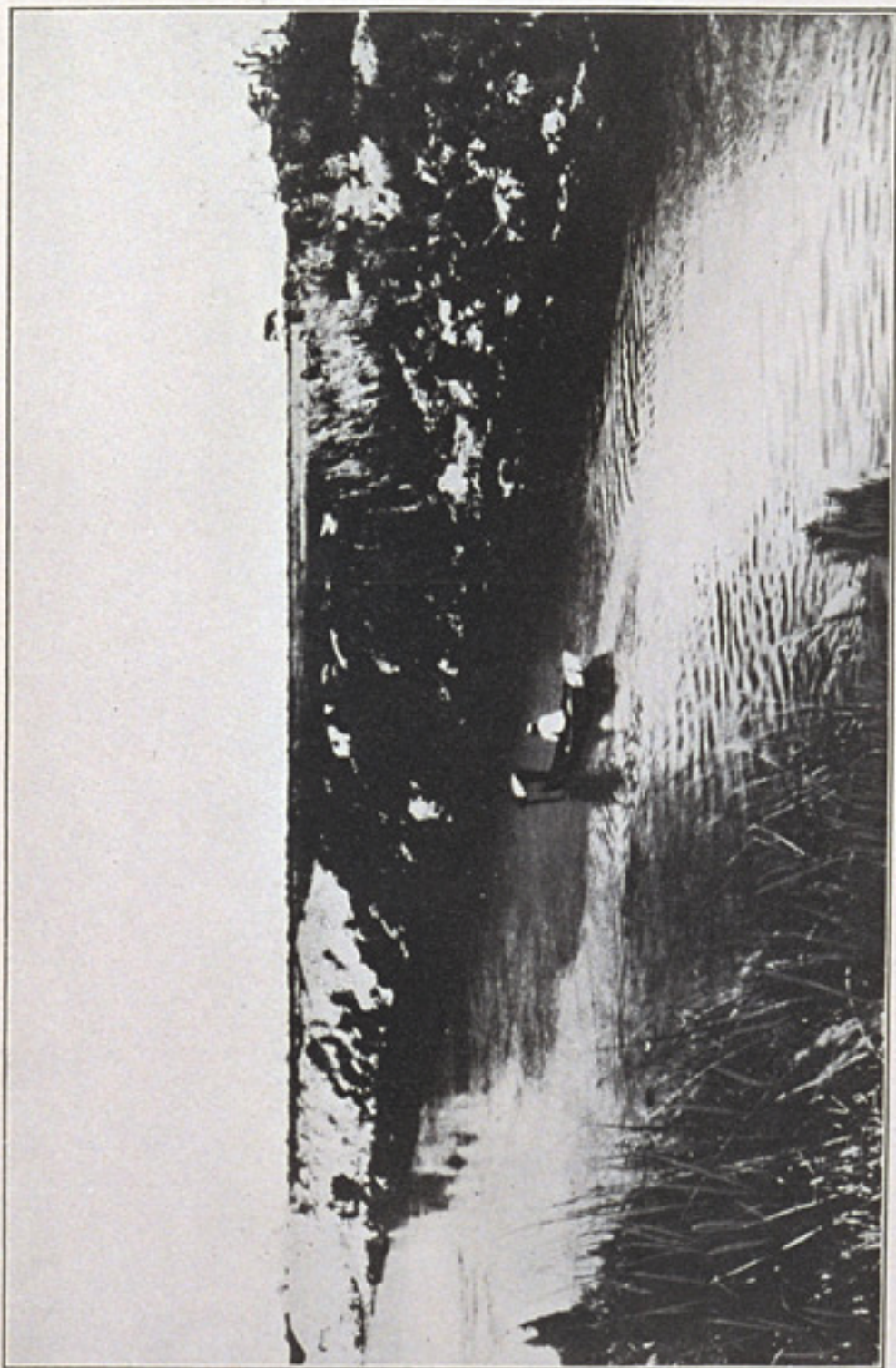
SOUTH NEW RIVER CANAL

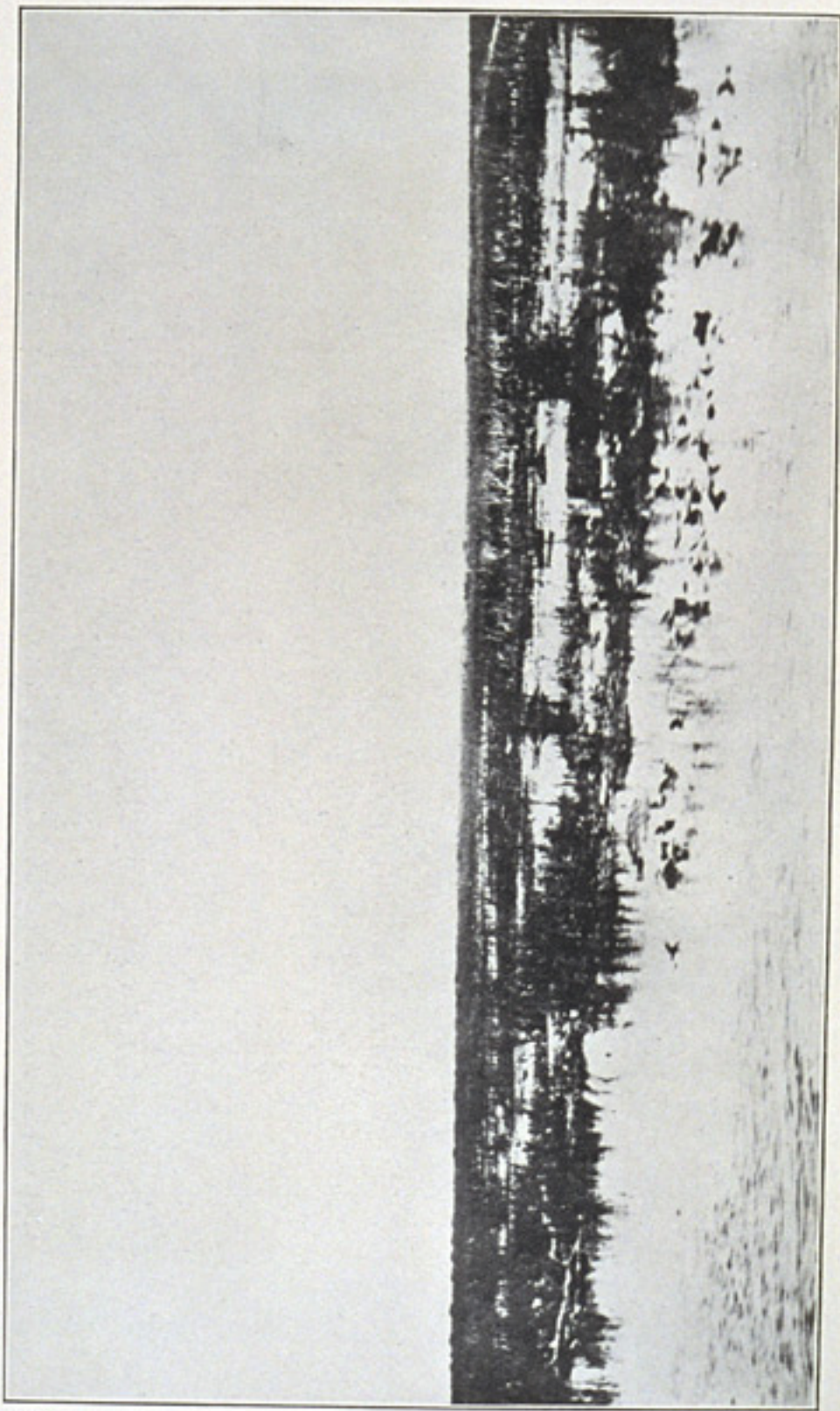
VIEW ON SOUTH NEW RIVER CANAL.

GAUGING STATION ON NORTH CANAL.

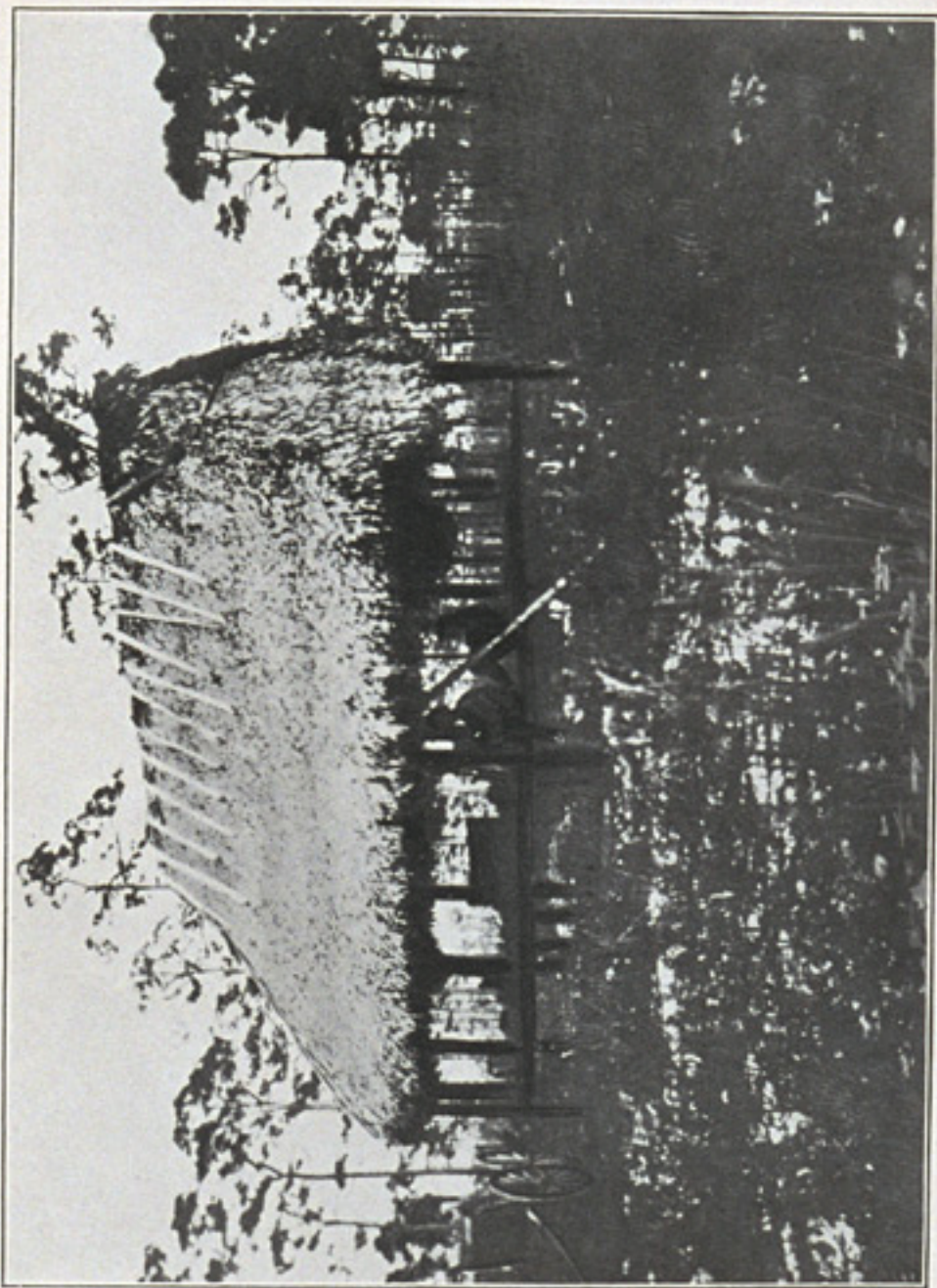

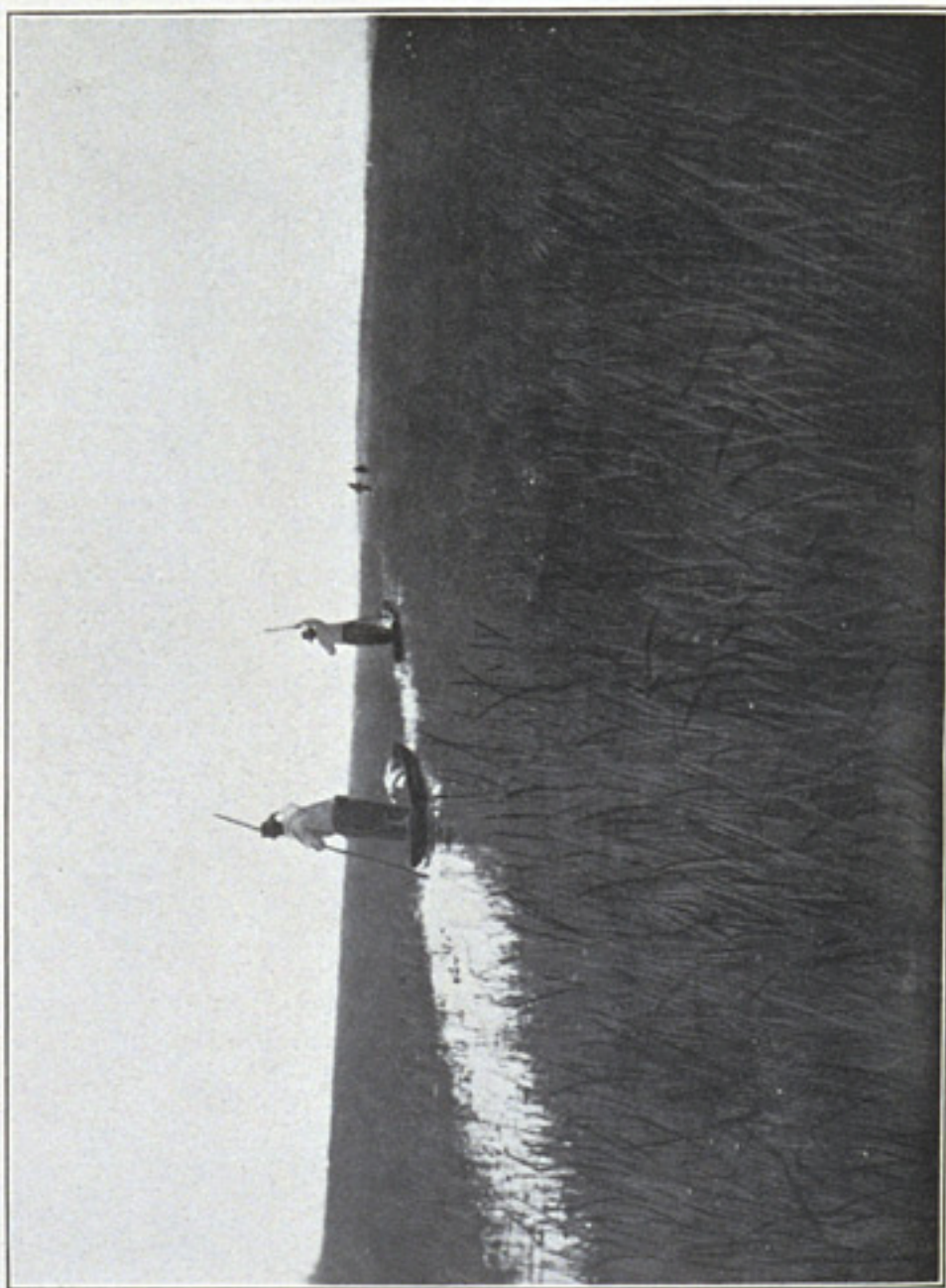
OPEN "GLADES," NORTH NEW RIVER CANAL.

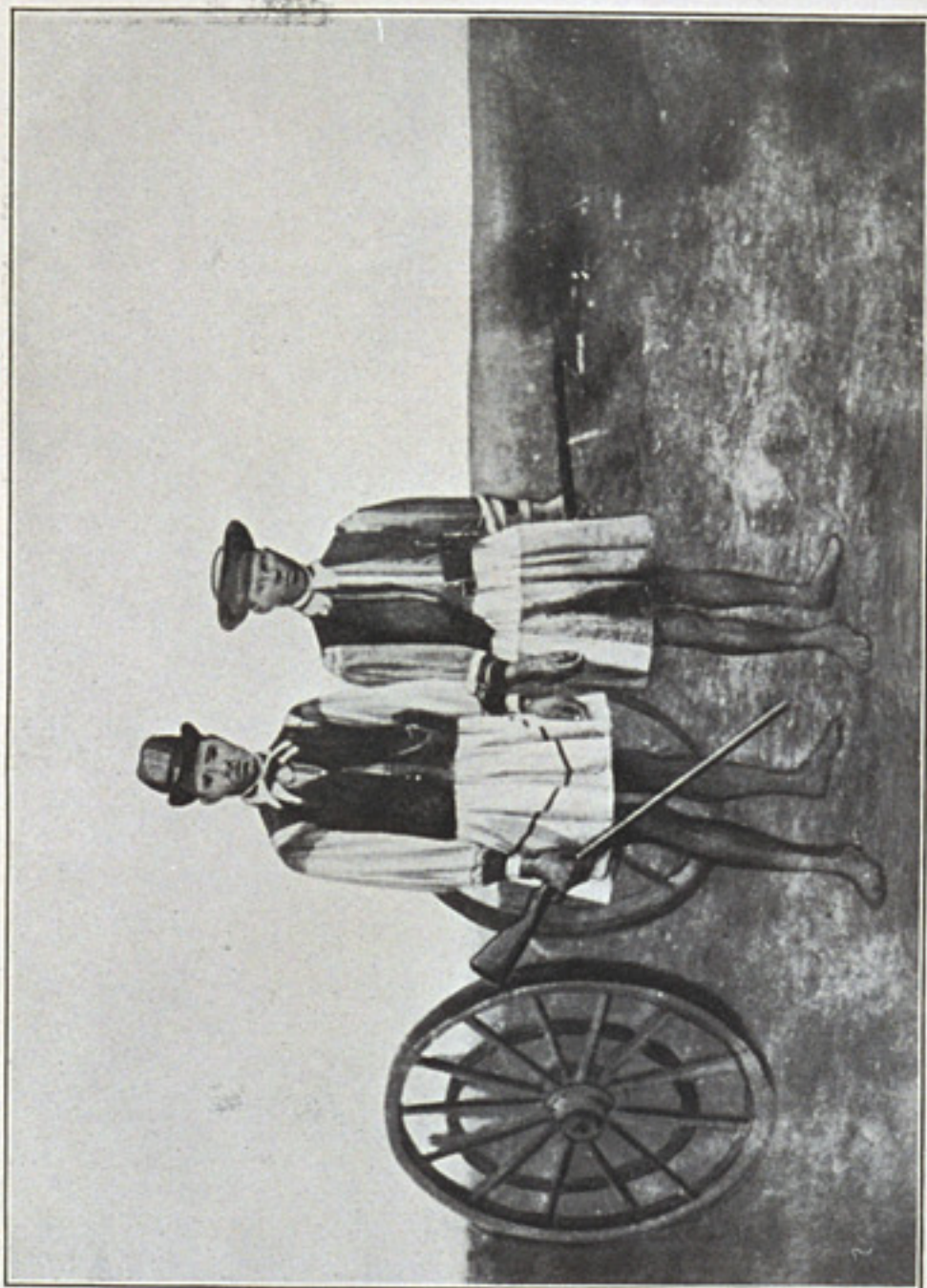

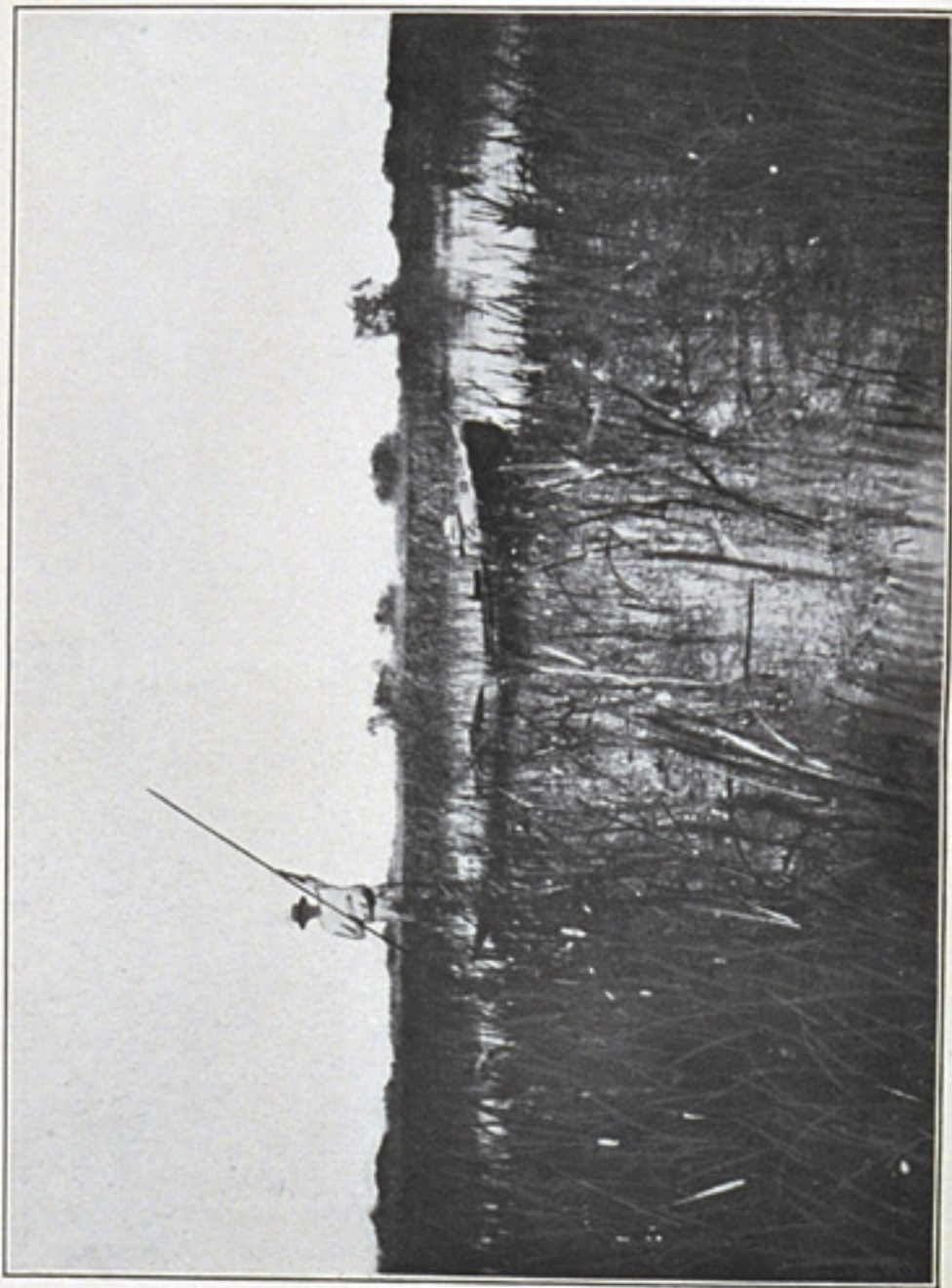

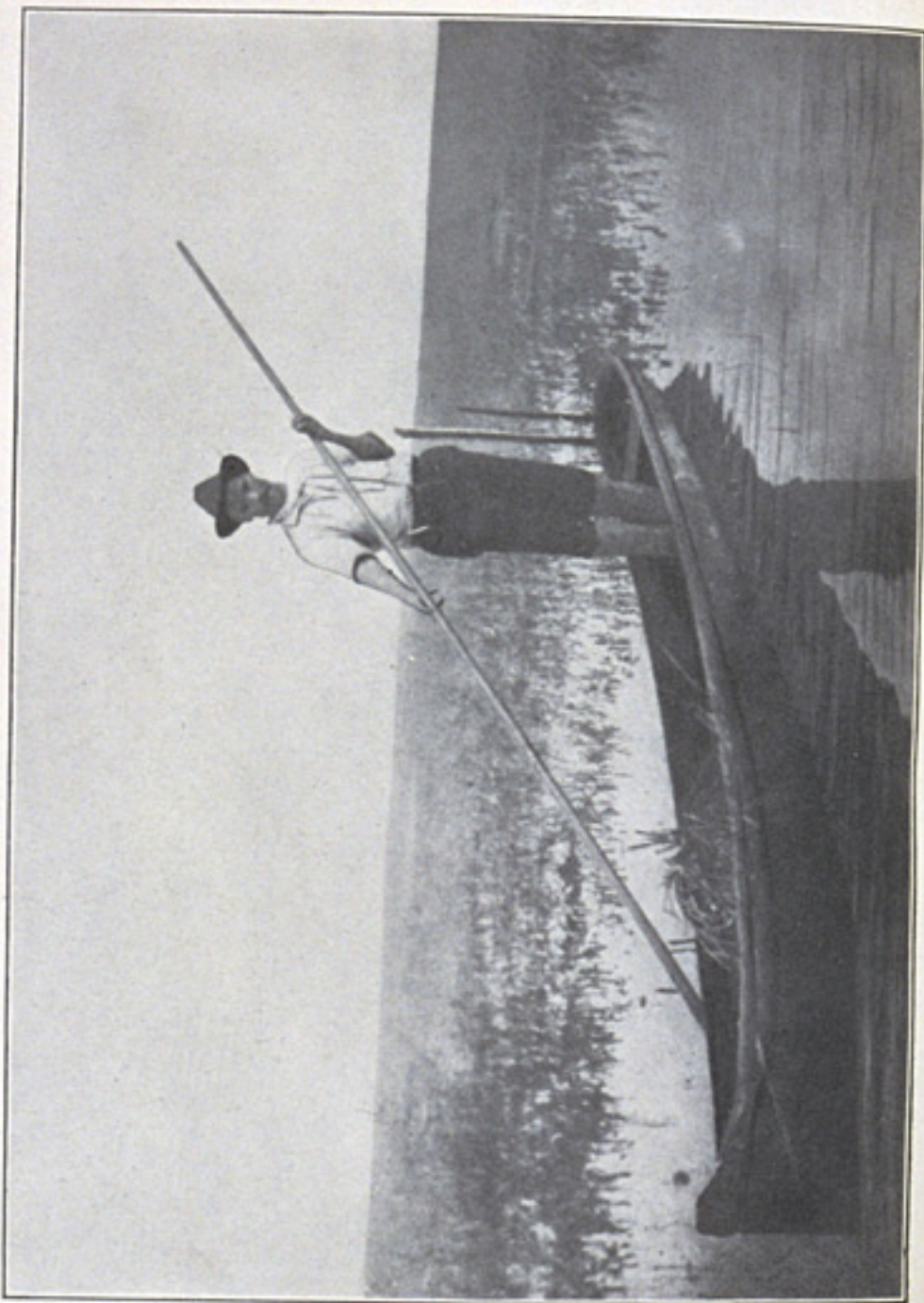

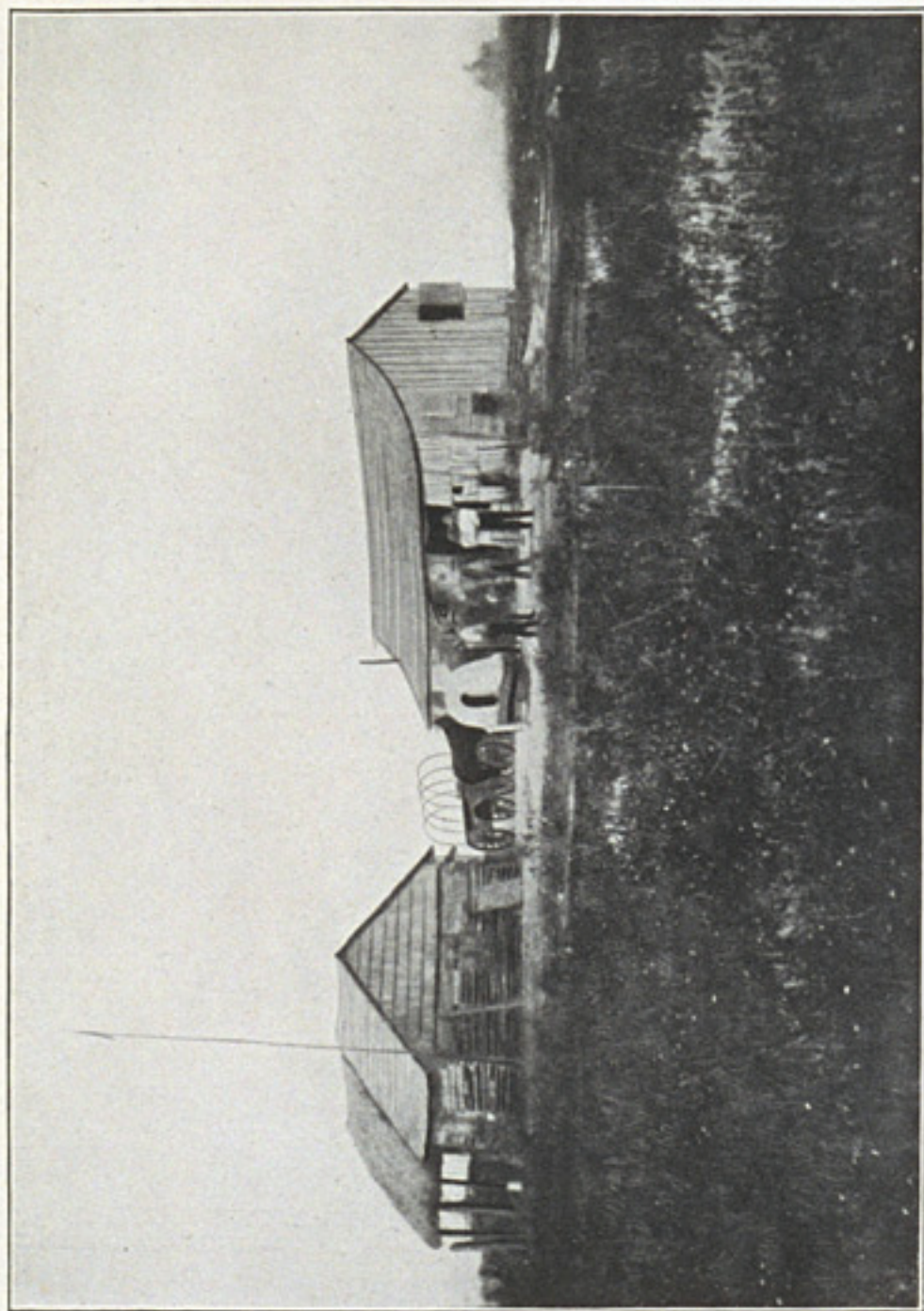

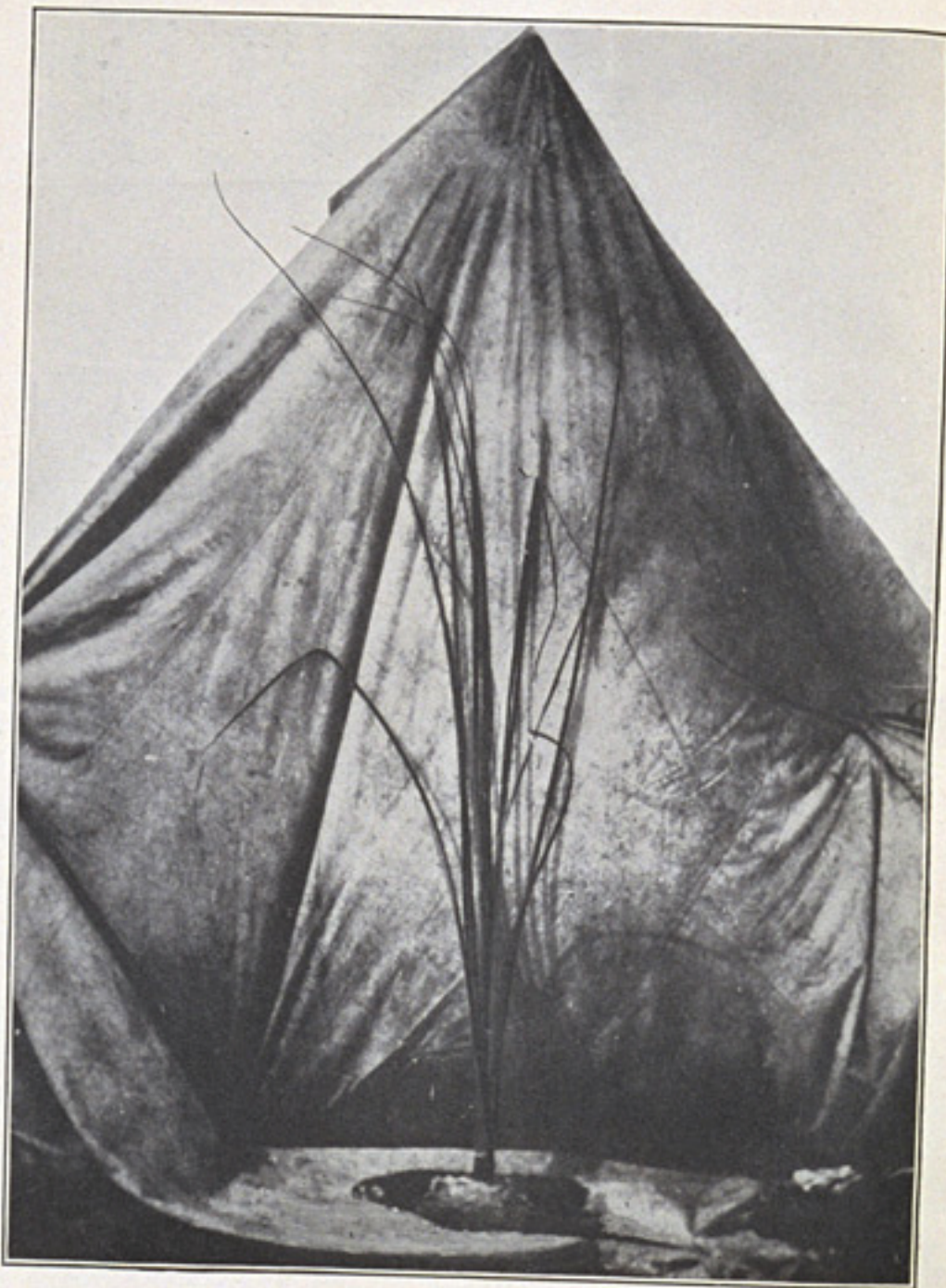
