My Dear Mr. Meade:-

As you know I am down here in Collier County where I own quite an acreage of land; I am engaged principally in growing sugar cane, have out about fifty acres now which will supply the seed cane for about one thousand acres which we hope to plant.

We do not desire for the first year or two to erect a sugar mill hence I am writing you to secure the lowest freight rate per ton on sugar cane from Carnestown or Copeland to Clewiston Florida. We feel that you will make this rate as low as consistent as it will add tonnage where no tonnage now exists.

Our shipping season would be December, January, February, March and perhaps into May each year.

We could load in flat cars or we could have the sugar mill supply us with their regulation cane cars.

Please give us this rate at as early a date as is convenient to you.
